

SUGGESTED CHANGES TO THE PAMPHLET "QUESTIONS & ANSWERS ON SPONSC
SUBMITTED BY KIM R., GSR FOR PEACE GROUP, DISTRICT 08020, AREA 47

Add this statement at the end of the 4th paragraph, page 7, to read:

"...sobriety through AA.[ADD]Ultimately, a sponsor is meant to guide the individual through the 12-step program of AA, as instructed in the book of Alcoholics Anonymous, and to introduce newcomer to the fellowship, service work, and the 12 traditions which hold the fellowship together.

Change the 1st statement on page 14 under the heading "When is a member ready for sponsor responsibility?" to read:

"The most successful sponsors are men and women who have worked the 12-step program guided by a sponsor of their own, and is now practicing the principles of the program in their lives; in other words, an individual who is "living" the AA program.[END OF CHANGE]The member who has been sober for months..."

Add this statement to the end of the 1st paragraph under the heading "How can the sponsor help the AA program?" on page 16:

"...to the newcomer at hand.[ADD]The primary sources for explanation of the Twelve Steps found in the AA literature, the books Alcoholics Anonymous and Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions."
